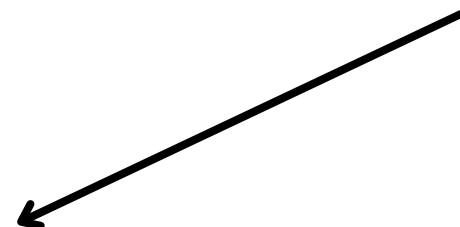

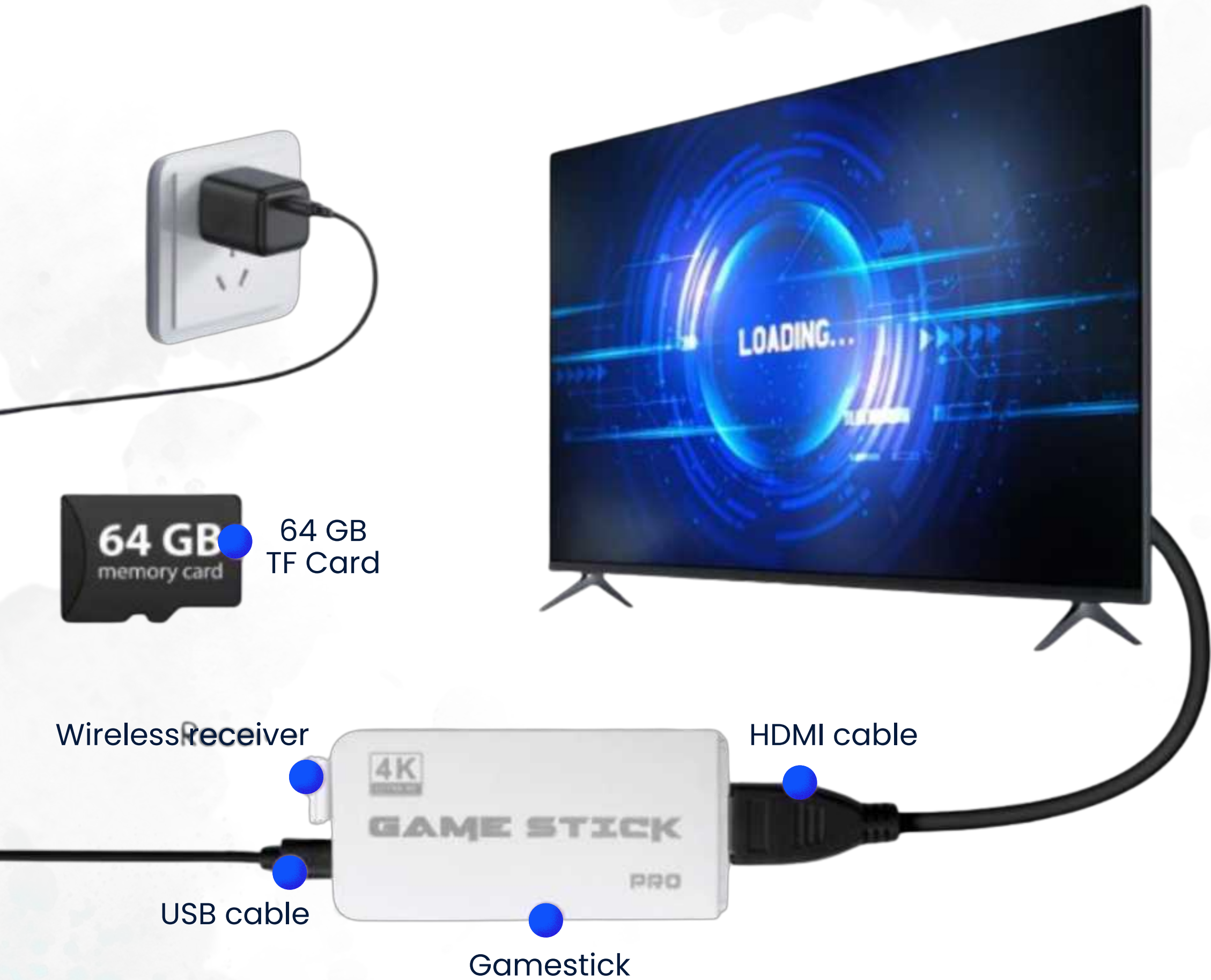

Setup

TV & Controller

1. Once all cables are connected and the console is hooked up to the TV, you should switch to the correct HDMI using the remote. From there, you should see the main menu.

2. Now you need to set up the controllers. Each controller uses 2 AAA batteries, which must be inserted on the back.

You should open the small cover and once the batteries are in, turn on the button on the front of the controller. The controller should then start to light up.

Remember: If the controller does not light up, you can try adjusting the batteries a little as this can sometimes help.

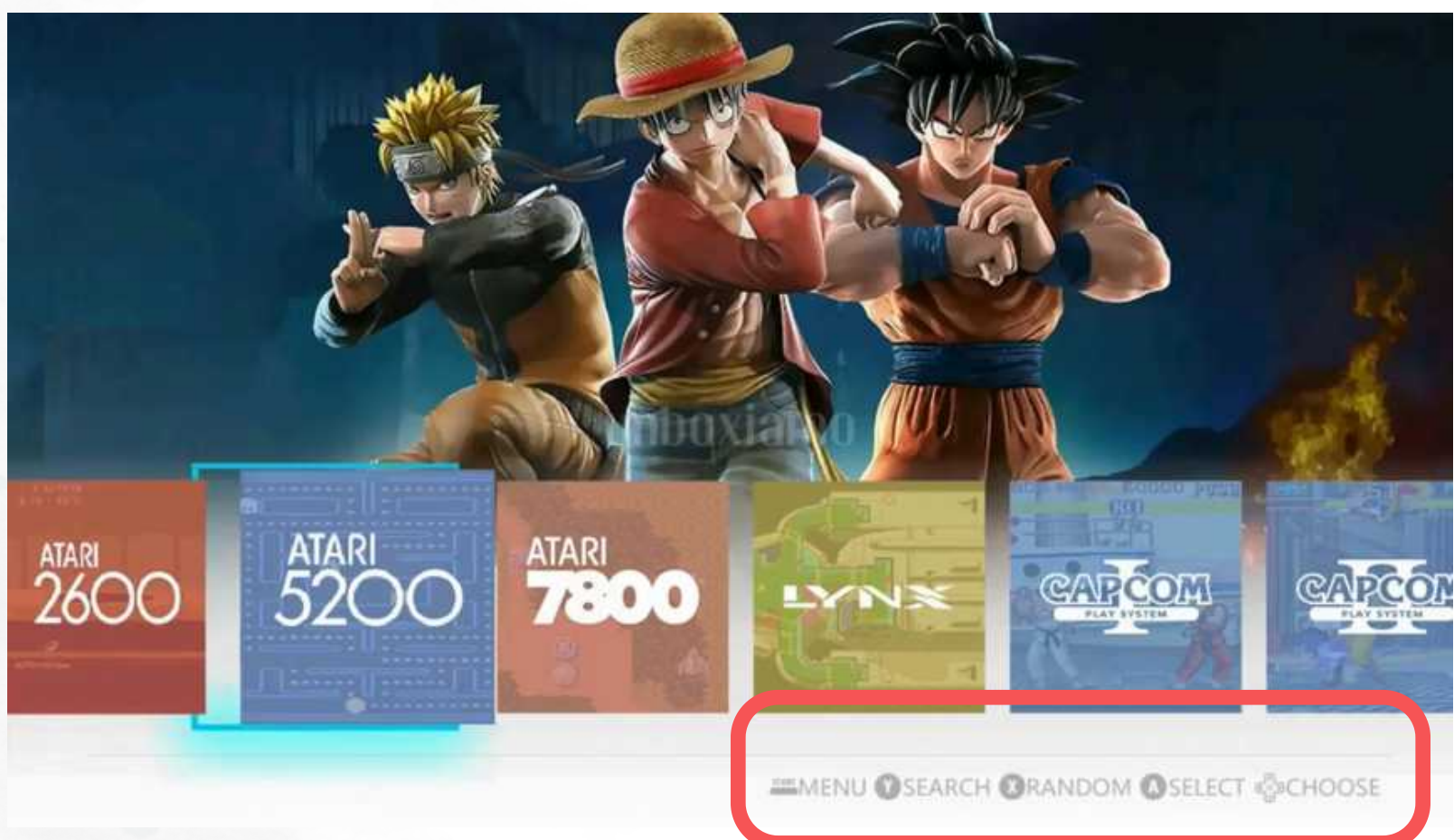


Functions

1. All games on the Gamestick are displayed on this page. You can scroll left and right to choose between the different game consoles.



2. In the bottom right corner, you are presented with options to search for specific games by pressing "Y". You can also go to the menu to change the language or browse between the different game consoles. You also have the option to view your favorite games.



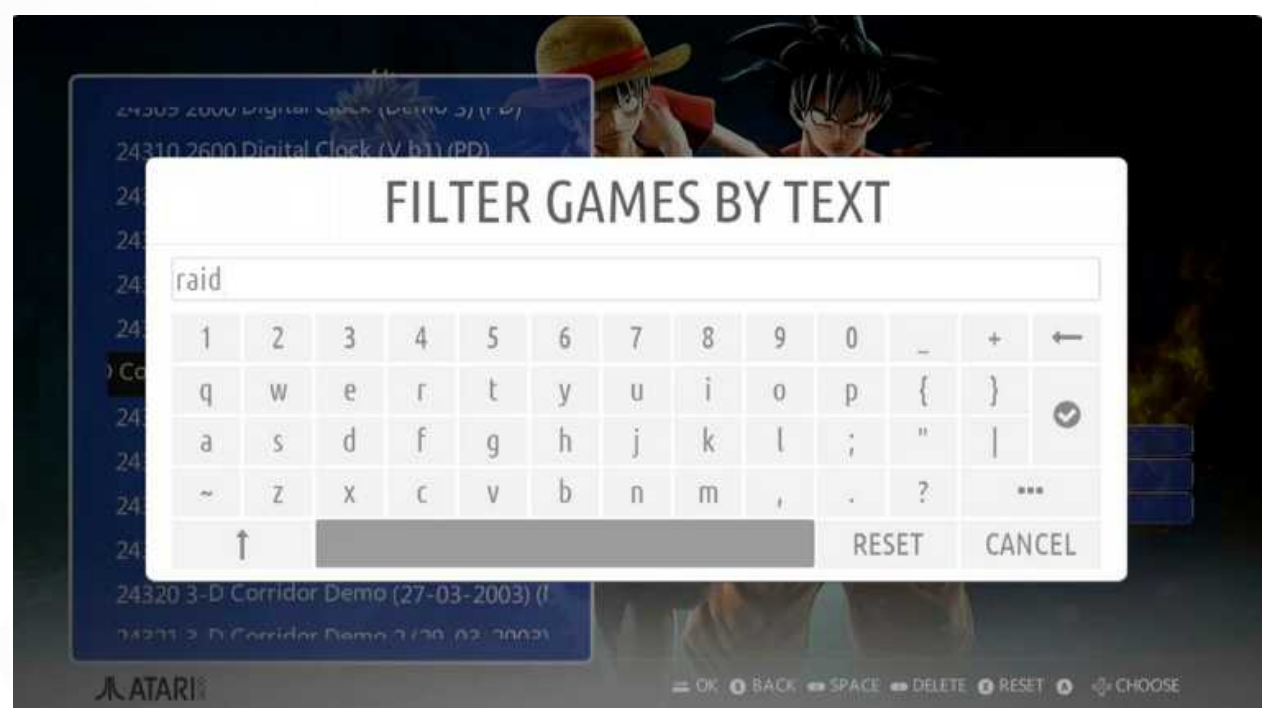
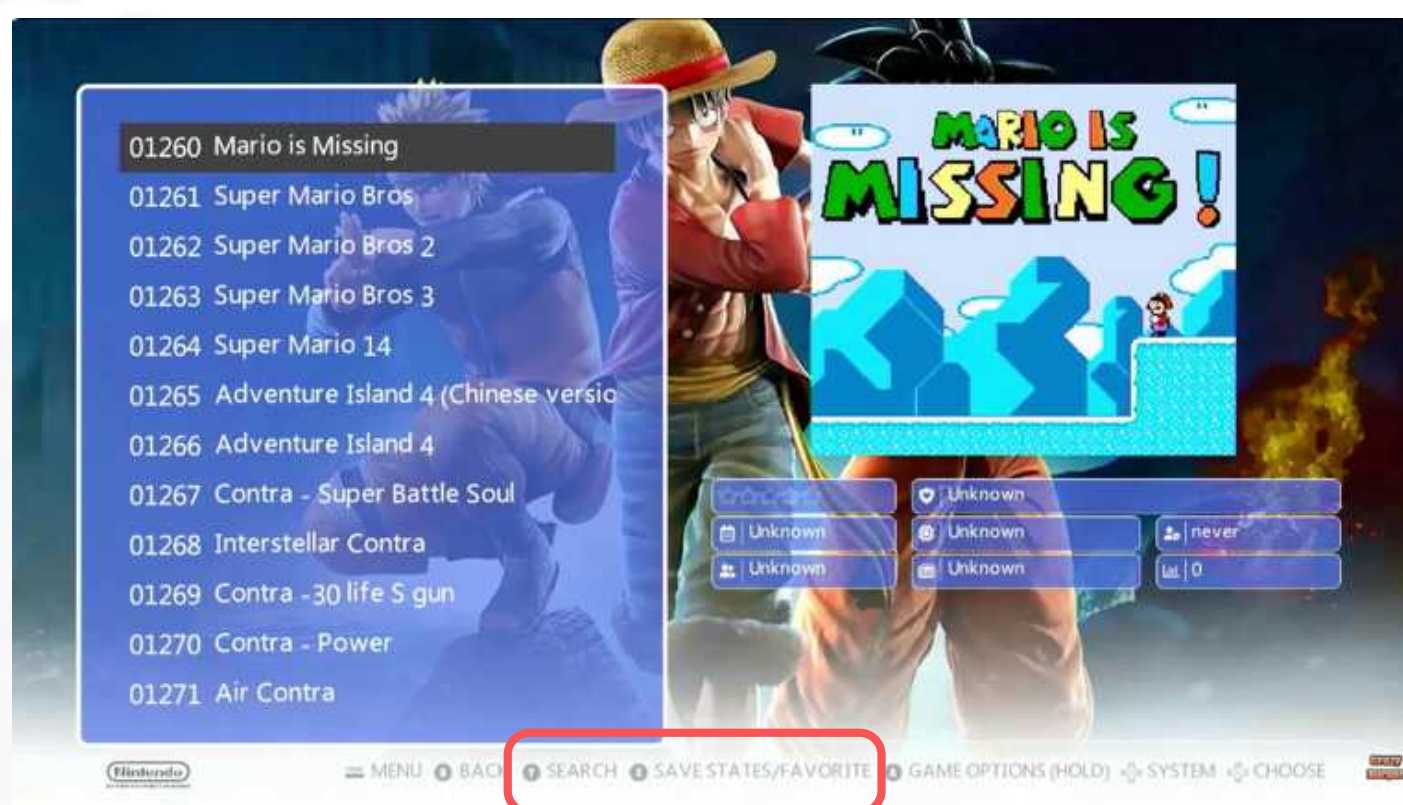
Functions

Once you have selected a game console, such as "PlayStation", you will be presented with a wide selection of games. You can browse through them by pressing the up or down arrow or by using the directional buttons.

In the bottom right corner of the screen, you will also see several options:

- Press "Y" to search for games
- Press "X" to save a game as a favorite

If a game is saved as a favorite, you can return to the home screen and view all your favorite games in a folder.



Functions

When you are in a game and want to exit it or save your progress, press “Select” and “Start” at the same time.

The menu will then appear, and you can choose between the options shown in the image below.



Problems

The following is for you in case you experience problems with the controller, Gamestick, or anything else during the setup. If this does not help, please contact our customer service at info@nordic-retro.com – we will be happy to assist you.

Controller Problems:

1. Insert the USB receiver (the small black USB stick) into the Gamestick.
2. Make sure the Gamestick is connected to both the HDMI and the power via the USB cable.
3. Insert new batteries into the controllers.
4. Turn on the controller by pressing the Start/Power button.

Does Not Appear on TV:

If you have set everything up and it still does not appear, you can try the following:

1. Remove the console from the TV and take all the parts apart.
2. Assemble it again and push the connectors in a little harder to make sure they are not loose.
3. Try different HDMI ports on the TV and without the HDMI extender.
4. Try both with the USB cable in the TV and in the adapter.

Often, problems with getting the picture to appear are caused by the connectors not being properly inserted. Sometimes you just need to try several times or in different ways.

Safety Instructions

To ensure proper use and a longer lifespan of the Gamestick console, it is important to follow these guidelines:

1. Read the safety information before using the console.
2. Installation and repair must be carried out by qualified personnel. Use only undamaged cables and accessories.
3. Do not place the console near flammable materials, explosive areas, or strong electromagnetic interference. Avoid direct sunlight.
4. Make sure the ventilation openings are not blocked so the console can cool properly.
5. Always use the supplied power supply or a compatible 5V/1A USB adapter.
6. Do not look directly at the indicator lights for extended periods.
7. Handle cables carefully: do not bend or pull them, do not place them under heavy objects, do not cover them, and avoid heat and moisture.
8. Use the console only indoors on a stable surface.
9. Small parts are dangerous for children under 3 years. Children aged 6–14 must use the console under supervision.
10. Disconnect the power when the console is not in use for an extended period.

By following these instructions, you minimize the risk of injury to people and damage to the device – and get the most out of your Retro Gamestick.

- 4.** If the temperature is 0 °C or lower, let the console sit at room temperature for 2 hours before use.
- 5.** Place the console on a stable surface – avoid moisture, dust, and direct sunlight.
- 6.** Use only original cables and controllers for proper operation.
- 7.** Do not look directly at the indicator lights for extended periods.
- 8.** Do not open or repair the console yourself – this may void the warranty.
- 9.** Read the entire manual and keep it for future reference. Turn off and disconnect the power when the console is not in use for an extended period. Ensure proper ventilation so the console does not overheat.
